SCHOOL COMPETITIVE FOOD SALES

The Board of Education believes sales of food and beverages at school during the school day shall align with the district's goals to promote student wellness. Any food sales conducted outside of the district's Nutrition Service Program shall meet nutritional standards as specified in law, Board Policy, and Administrative Regulation, and shall not reduce student participation in the district's Nutrition Services Program.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to approve the sale of food and beverages outside the district's Nutrition Services Program, including sales by student or school-connected organizations, sales through vending machines, and/or sales at secondary school student stores or parent organization groups for fundraising purposes. When vending machines are sponsored by the district, or a student, or outside organization, the Superintendent or designee shall determine how and where vending machines may be placed at school sites, district offices, or other school facilities.
