RESIGNATION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Any Board member who chooses to resign shall file a written resignation with the County Superintendent of Schools, Orange County.

A copy shall be given to the Board secretary.

The resignation shall be effective upon its filing except where a deferred effective date is specified in the resignation.

A Board member may not defer the effective date of his or her resignation for more than 60 days after he or she files the resignation with the County Superintendent of Schools.

Any written resignation, whether specifying a deferred effective date or otherwise, shall be irrevocable upon its filing with the County Superintendent of Schools.

A Board member who has filed a resignation may continue to exercise all his/her powers, save that of voting for a successor, until the effective date of resignation.

When possible, a Board member who chooses to resign should announce his or her intention at the regularly scheduled Board meeting prior to the filing of a resignation.

Any vacancies on the Board occurring from Board member resignation shall be resolved in accordance with Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District Policy 9112, "Filling Vacancies."
