REPRESENTATIVE AND DELIBERATIVE GROUPS

The Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District believes that input on district operations and policy from staff, parents/guardians, students and members of the public can provide the district with a diversity of view points and expertise, enhance district efficiency, and assist district communications. As desired, the Superintendent or designee may establish a management team, administrative councils, task forces, cabinets or committees in accordance with law.

The membership, composition and responsibilities of these groups shall be defined by the Superintendent or designee. The Superintendent may establish, change or dissolve these groups at his/her discretion.

Groups established by the Superintendent or designee shall act in an advisory capacity unless specifically authorized to act on behalf of the superintendent or designee.
