## ADMISSION OF KINDERGARTEN PUPILS TO FIRST GRADE

### A. <u>Purpose and Scope</u>

To provide a specific framework for admission of kindergarten pupils to the first grade

- B. General
  - 1. A child who is at least five years of age and who has completed one year of kindergarten in public or private school (full year of at least 180-minute sessions) shall be admitted to first grade.
  - 2. A child may be admitted to the first grade at the discretion of the school administration in accordance with the procedures listed below.

#### D. Procedure

- 1. In determining if a child is ready for first grade, the California Administrative Code states that procedures adopted by school districts shall insure that a kindergarten pupil placed in the first grade meets the following minimum criteria:
  - a. The child is at least five years of age.
  - b. The child has attended a public school kindergarten for a minimum of three weeks to enable school personnel to evaluate his or her grade level readiness.
  - c. The parent or guardian of the child has filed with the school district a written statement approving placement in the first grade.
- 2. Parents must register their children at the school in their assigned attendance area.
- 3. A request for the child's acceleration may be initiated by the school principal, teacher, psychologist, or the child's parent or guardian.
- 4. A child must spend a minimum of three weeks in a public school kindergarten prior to advancement to the first grade. This is to provide adequate time for evaluation of the child.

- 5. No child shall be accelerated after the beginning of the second trimester of the kindergarten year.
- 6. The following data will also be considered an important aspect of the evidence supporting acceleration:
  - a. Social/Emotional maturity
  - b. Physical maturity
  - c. Current academic achievement
- 7. The school appraisal team will consider the data.
- 8. A conference will be held by the principal with the parent or guardian of the pupil, indicating the decision of the school appraisal team, during which time a written statement approving placement in the first grade will be obtained if this has been the decision of the school appraisal team and the parent.
